

Why is this consolidation of these precincts desirable?</b> <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> This is the same plan used in the last election It puts all voters from Magisterial District 2 together, continuing to offer a polling location without voters having to drive outside their geographic area. Deer Creek Baptist Church, a longtime polling location for B101, has more-than-adequate parking, is ADA accessible and has updated facilities. It also lies dead-center of the district.

This configuration was utilized for three previous elections with zero issues with accessibility or delays in voting.

At Deer Creek Baptist Church, voters from both precincts have proper facilities with ADA accessibility, abundant parking and room for adequate social distancing. <b>1.) Why is this consolidation of these precincts desirable?</b> <input type="checkbox"/> This is the same plan used in the last election The three days of early voting can be adequately served in the new county office complex, which offers ADA accessibility, adequate on-site parking and room for social distancing unlike the previous courthouse. Early voting would be held in the fiscal court room, which is near the front of the facility with direct access from two public entrances.
<b>2.) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?</b> <input type="checkbox"/> This location will be fully staffed with election officials Early voting will be staffed by a traditional complement of poll workers (balance of parties with clerk, sheriff and opposite party judges).
<b>3.) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a "Vote Center?"</b> Local newspaper and radio station multiple times from now until the election. Facebook. Clerk and county website. Flyers posted in office and county office complex. "Early Voting" signage.
<b>4.) How will the voting location serve as a focal point to meet the needs of a diverse community?</b> The county office complex is the geographic center of the community, and for the first time, voting at the home of county offices is fully ADA-compliant. This site was used as the 2020 general election countywide Voting Center with zero complaints or issues with accessibility or delays in voting. It also offers a kitchenette for poll workers and direct access to the county clerk's office for voter registration questions.

Why is this consolidation of these precincts desirable?</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> This is the same plan used in the last election</p> <p>This is a new consolidation of precincts at a location formerly serving only one rural precinct (A102). Due to low turnout from A102, it is more efficient for precinct officers to serve voters in additional precincts whose boundaries converge less than a half-mile from the site.</p>
<p><b>2.) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?</b></p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> This location will be fully staffed with election officials</p> <p>One set of precinct workers only would be used for the combined precincts.</p>
<p><b>3.) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a "Vote Center?"</b></p> <p>Local newspaper and radio station multiple times from now until the election. Facebook. Flyers posted in courthouse.</p>
<p><b>4.) How will the voting location serve as a focal point to meet the needs of a diverse community?</b></p> <p>Geographically, it serves a rural, sparsely populated area in the eastern half of Crittenden County. It will serve as the nearest location for A102's 408 voters and a small number voters in the three other precincts (approximately 400) who reside further than 5 miles from the next nearest voting site.</p>

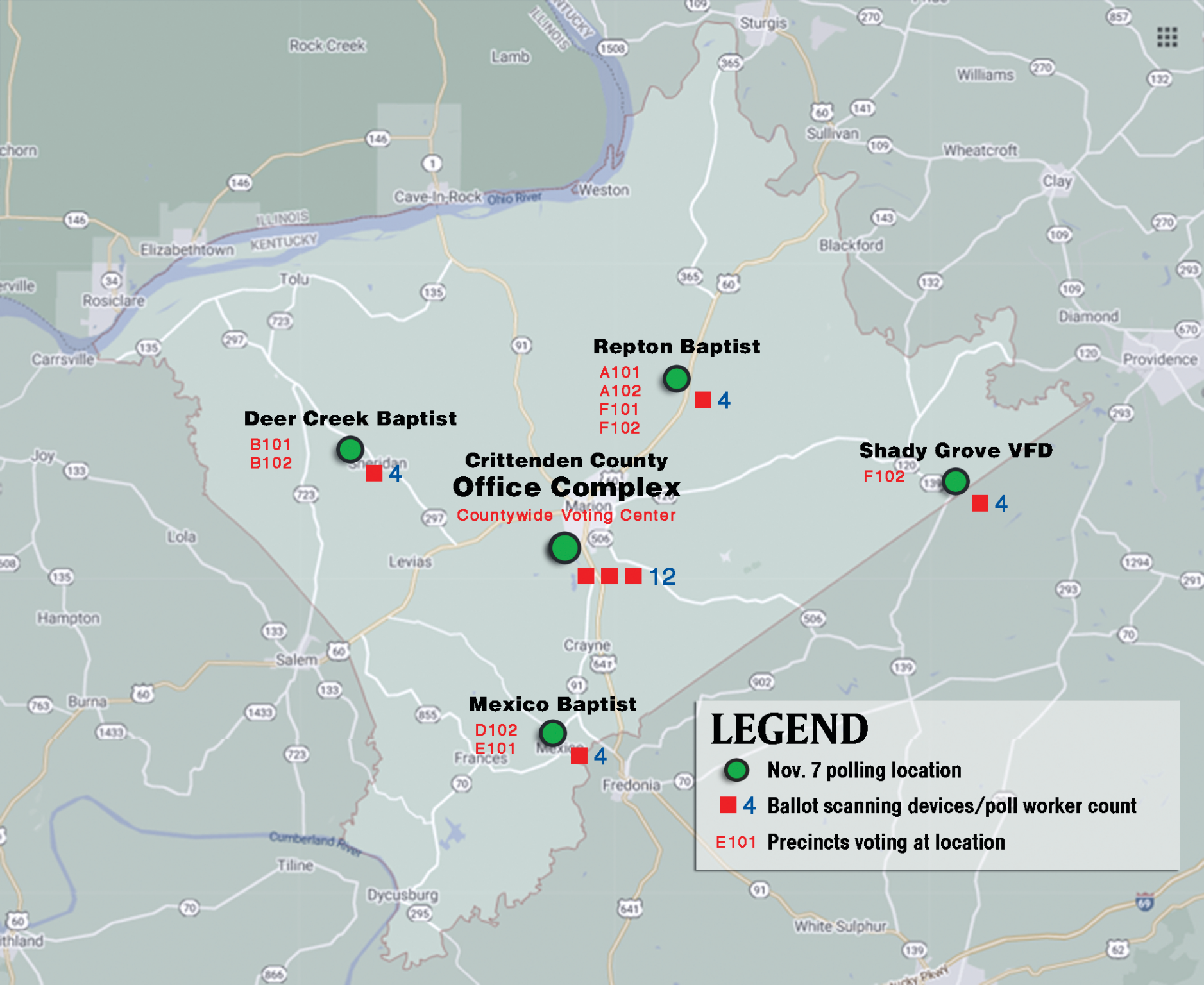

Why is this consolidation of these precincts desirable?</b>  <input type="checkbox"/> This is the same plan used in the last election</p> <p>It offers an ideal way to vote for all six precincts that traditionally voted within a 1-mile radius at separate locations in the City of Marion, and the new County Office Complex provides more-than-adequate parking, is ADA accessible and has updated facilities. For rural voters who work in the city, it is also ideal.</p>
<p><b>2.) In what manner will Precinct Officers be assigned?</b>  <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> This location will be fully staffed with election officials</p> <p>As a county-wide Voting Center, three full-sets of poll workers would be used. Six rural precincts are covered with voting locations in their geographic area. The plan for a Voting Center has been used in the three prior elections and this location was used in the 2020 presidential election with zero complaints or issues with accessibility or delays in voting.</p>
<p><b>3.) How will the voting location be publicized to voters? How will the location be noted as a "Vote Center?"</b></p> <p>Local newspaper and radio station multiple times from now until the election. Facebook. Clerk and county website. Flyers posted in the courthouse.</p>
<p><b>4.) How will the voting location serve as a focal point to meet the needs of a diverse community?</b></p> <p>The county office complex is the geographic center of the community, and for the first time, voting in the home of county offices is fully ADA-compliant. It also offers a kitchenette for poll workers and direct access to the county clerk's office for voter registration questions.</p>
