6-Day Excused Early Voting: Rockcastle County Courthouse 205 East Main Street, Mt. Vernon, KY 40456 (Clerk's Office)

3-Day No-Excuse In-Person Absentee Voting: Rockcastle County Courthouse 205 East Main Street, Mt. Vernon, KY 40456 (3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Conference Room) Thursday, November 2, 2023 (10AM-6PM), Friday, November 3, 2023 (6AM-2PM), Saturday, November 4, 2023 (8AM-4PM).

Election Day, November 7, 2023: Rockcastle County will have four Voting Supercenters, meaning ALL precinct ballots will be available at each location, on Election Day from 6AM-6PM. Rockcastle County voters may use whichever location works best for them.

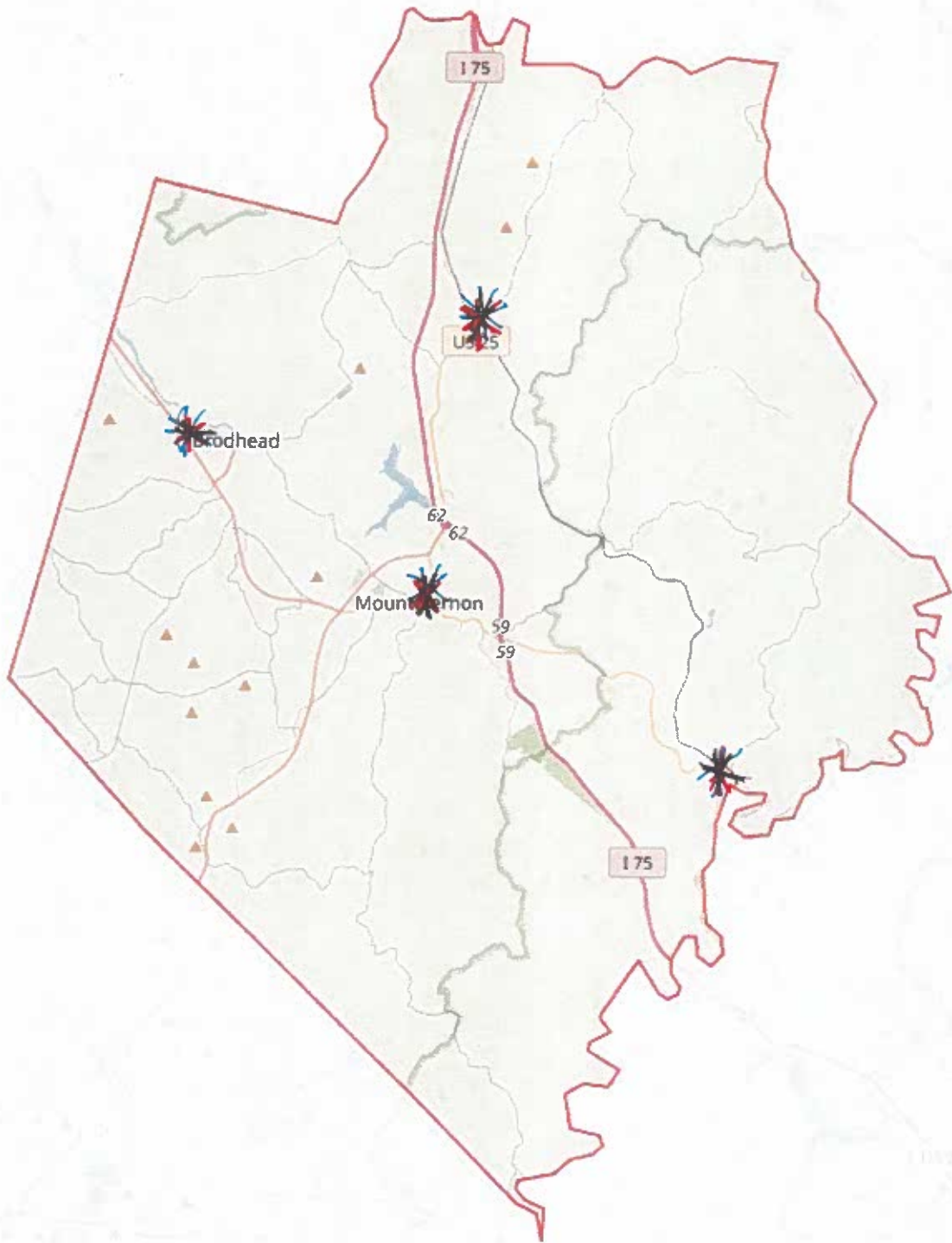
